Development Issue 2-1	<p>[Background and current situation] In Sri Lanka, 27% of its labor force is engaged in agricultural sector, and 92% of poverty stricken population lives in rural or estate communities where main industries are agriculture and fishery. In addition, there are several areas in the country, including the Northern and Eastern Provinces, whose development are impeded by the conflict in the past. This has widened regional and income disparities between urban areas where economic growth is unhindered and those areas where development is less pronounced. Therefore, it is crucial to improve livelihoods of such less developed area through industrial development as well as to uplift living environments of conflict affected areas.</p>					<p>[Strategy] In order to eliminate regional disparities in the country, Japan supports the development of agriculture and fishery which are the main industries in less developed rural areas, with due consideration for the impact of climate change. Japan also extends assistance towards improving peoples' living environments and economic activities, while promoting social cohesion in conflict affected areas including the Northern and Eastern Provinces, taking into consideration the complexity of the political and social dynamics as well as the vulnerables.</p>

Development Issue 3-1 Social Infrastructure Development for Mitigating Vulnerability	<p>[Background and current situation] Though Sri Lanka is making steady economic progress after the end of the conflict, people are still vulnerable to various risks in their daily life.</p> <p><Disaster Prevention> The Government and people are increasingly aware of disasters, in the face of large-scale natural disasters that occur due to climate change etc. However, public investment is concentrated on post-disaster responses and recovery because of the limited availability of finances. Therefore, it has been required to mitigate disaster risks and damages through prior investment in preventive measures.</p> <p><Social Services> Sri Lanka's consistent policies of "Free Education and Free Health" since independence have contributed towards achieving high literacy rates and salutary health and medical standard. On the other hand, newly emerging issues such as ageing and Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) including lifestyle-related diseases, which increase mortality rate, need to be addressed by developing social service platform which responds to the societal change. In addition, economic disparity has become a serious issue, while economic development has been progressing. In particular, social inclusion of Persons With Disabilities (PWDs) have not been realized satisfactory, and strengthening PWDs' access to education and employment has been an outstanding issue in order to facilitate social participation of PWDs.</p> <p><Security/Governance> Following the Easter Sunday Attacks in April 2019, strengthening of the security and governance has become an urgent issue. In addition, following the global pandemic of COVID-19, emergency assistance is sought to contain the spread of COVID-19.</p>					<p>[Strategy] <Disaster Prevention> Japan places emphasis on the formulation of the Disaster Risk Reduction Plans at national/local level and infrastructure development for disaster prevention, based on Japanese experience and expertise in disaster management, as well as international trends such as the "Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030," which includes the concept of "Build Back Better" and importance of prior investments in disaster risk reduction and prevention.</p> <p><Social Services> Japan supports efforts for improvements and cost reductions of public services through the strengthening of diagnosis/treatment centering on NCDs and management systems, as well as services delivery for elderly care. In addition, Japan also focuses on strengthening social services for vulnerable groups, including PWDs (infants), through the development of educational and employment support systems.</p> <p><Security/Governance> Japan supports measures to strengthen security and governance, through assistance against violent extremism and illegal drugs, and support for empowerment of women.</p>
